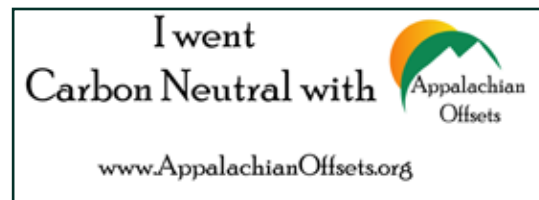


Appalachian Offsets is Different

Appalachian Offsets is a voluntary Carbon Offset program to combat global climate change through local renewable energy and efficiency projects in WNC.

While it is best to first reduce the amount of greenhouse gas you or your business produces, you can also offset your impact by supporting our programs that will reduce the amount of carbon and greenhouse gases generated in our community and would not have happened without your contribution.

The first project will replace incandescent light bulbs with compact fluorescents (CFLs) in the Asheville Housing Authority's low-income rental housing. A single CFL will save 425 pounds of coal that would release 583 pounds of carbon dioxide and 17 pounds of sulphur dioxide, not to mention a variety of other harmful pollutants. Participants in this project will be helping to clean the air for the region's future generations and save money for those who need it most.



What are Carbon Offsets?

Global climate change is a crisis caused by human activities, so it is up to us to reverse the trend. A carbon offset is purchased to neutralize the impact of a carbon emission. For example, if you were to purchase 5 tons of carbon offsets, a renewable energy or efficiency project will be implemented that will eliminate 5 tons of carbon dioxide from being released into the air.

Carbon offsets are a great way to learn about how you use energy in your personal life or business and with Appalachian Offsets, you be a part of the solution in your local community.

Be a Part of the Solution Locally

Offsetting a ton of carbon costs about \$15. If members of an organization get together to purchase an offset, it can reduce the cost per ton and make a large impact. Additionally, if a business or organization offsets their entire footprint, they can market themselves as "Carbon Neutral".

Becoming 'carbon neutral' means that you have neutralized the effect of your greenhouse gas emissions, so that your activities no longer contribute to the dangers of global climate change. Be a part of the solution and act locally to prevent global pollution!
